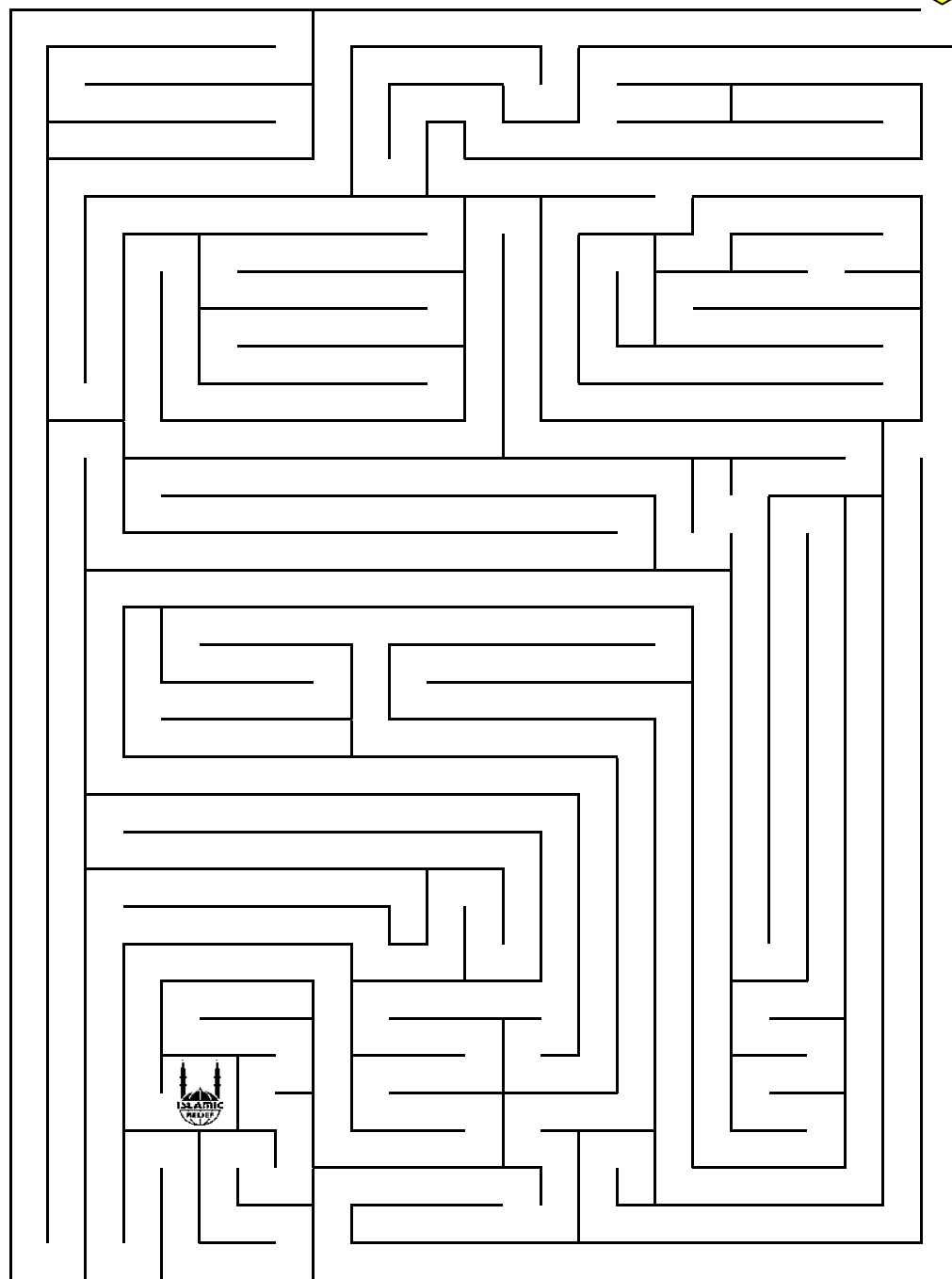

Alhamdulillah, my gran is much better now. My dad is so happy and he was especially proud of Amina and I.

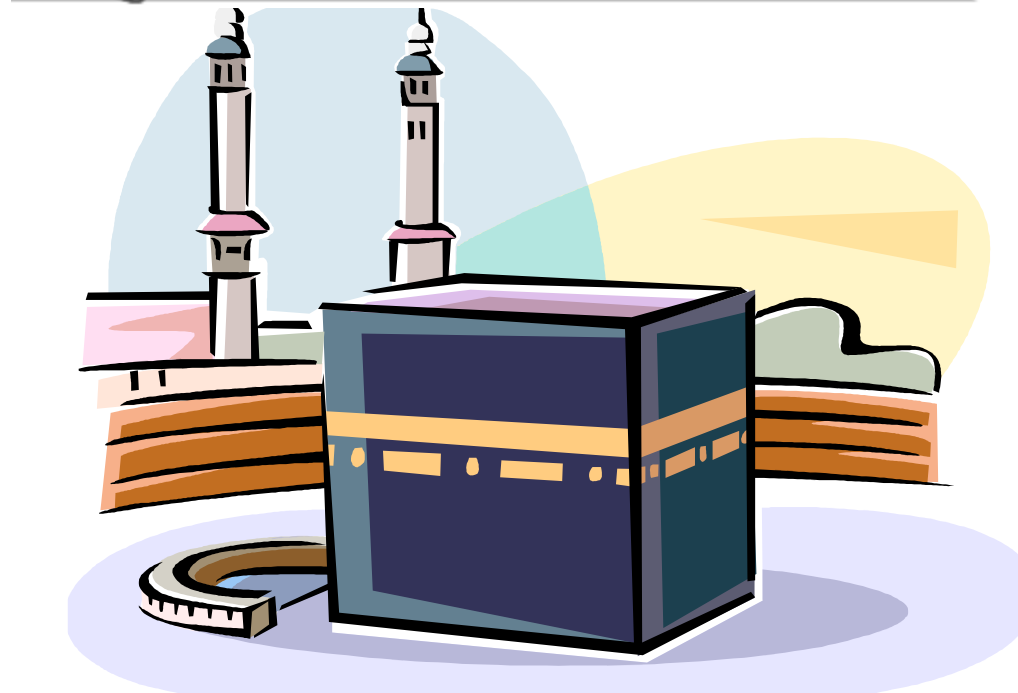
Since we behaved so well my dad said that we can have a special reward - anything we like.

Everyone has responsibilities make sure you fulfil yours .

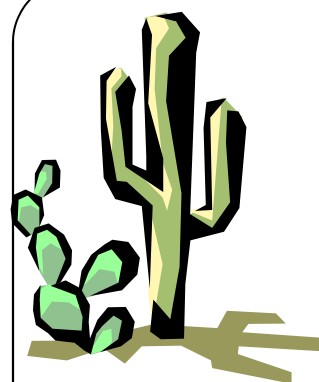
Muhammad (pbuh) is our role-model so always follow his example.
